Student activities

Volunteering

Student Opportunities

Microgrant fund for student ideas and **employability** digital badges issued to all student volunteers

Additional support: Recycling Audits

Recycling audits provide a visual check of all bins in shared kitchens to give you a greater understanding on recycling habits and to feedback to students on their performance.

- Communal **waste bins are audited** by paid trained students (payments at the real living wage are included in the fee).
- **Bins are scored** to ascertain levels of contamination and record key data.
- **Feedback is shared** with students on their performance, with high-scoring kitchens receiving Fairtrade chocolate.
- An **audit report** presents scores, waste trends and key recommendations.
