- **Tried and tested** student-led methodology co-created with students in 2018, refined over nearly a decade
- **Students are trained** to identify how sustainability is embedded into teaching and learning
 - Sustainable development goals (SDGs)
 - Sustainability and green skills
 - Methods that support sustainability learning (Education for Sustainable Development)
 - Students may map their weekly experience of teaching and learning over a period of time, or a set of module descriptors or schemes of learning
- **Reports providing data, findings and recommendations** on how students experience the inclusion of sustainability in their learning

Over **600** students have led curriculum mapping projects



Students have mapped over **8000** modules and over **4500** weeks of teaching and learning

- **Uncovered areas of good practice**, and areas for improvement

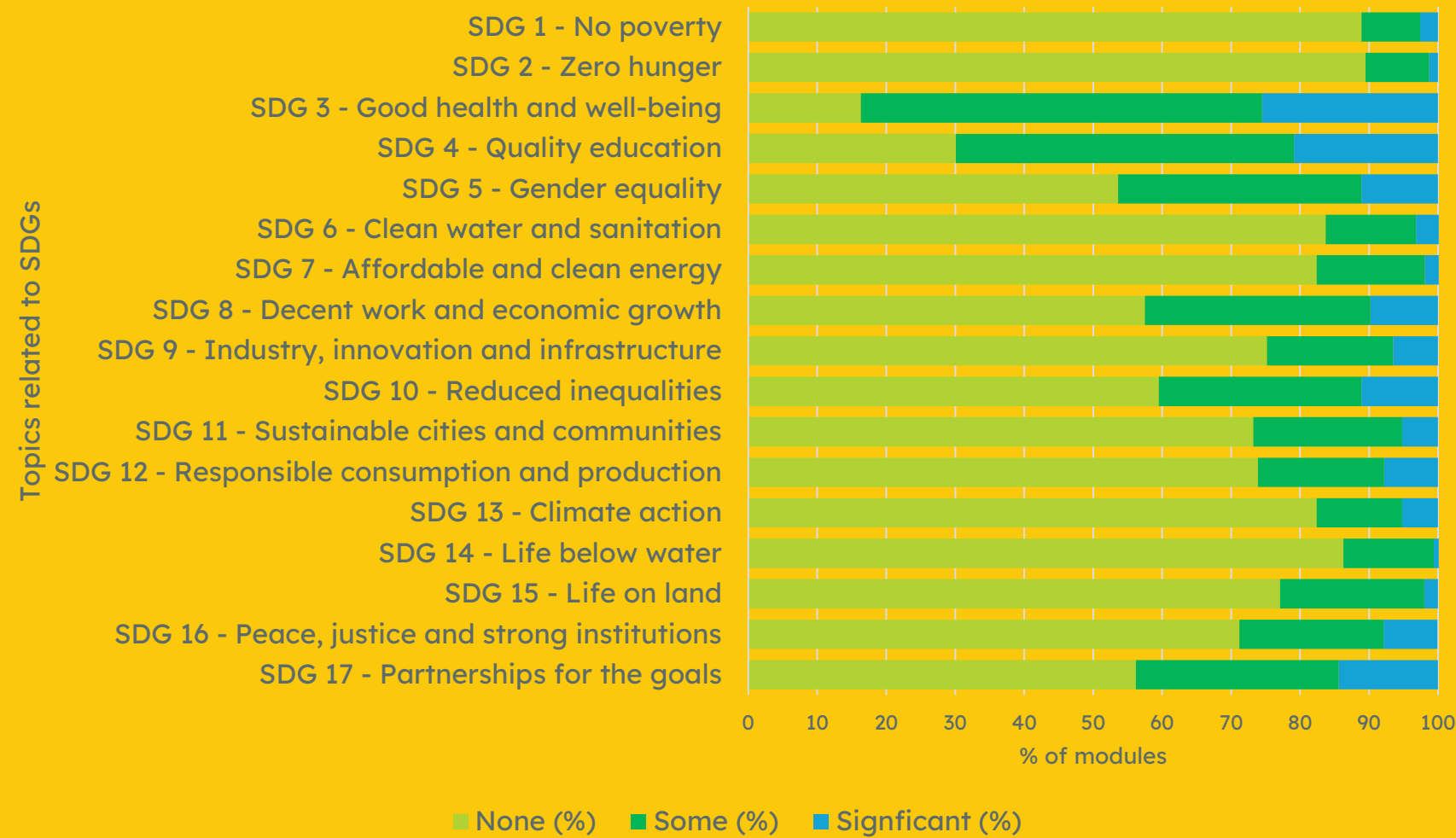
How it works



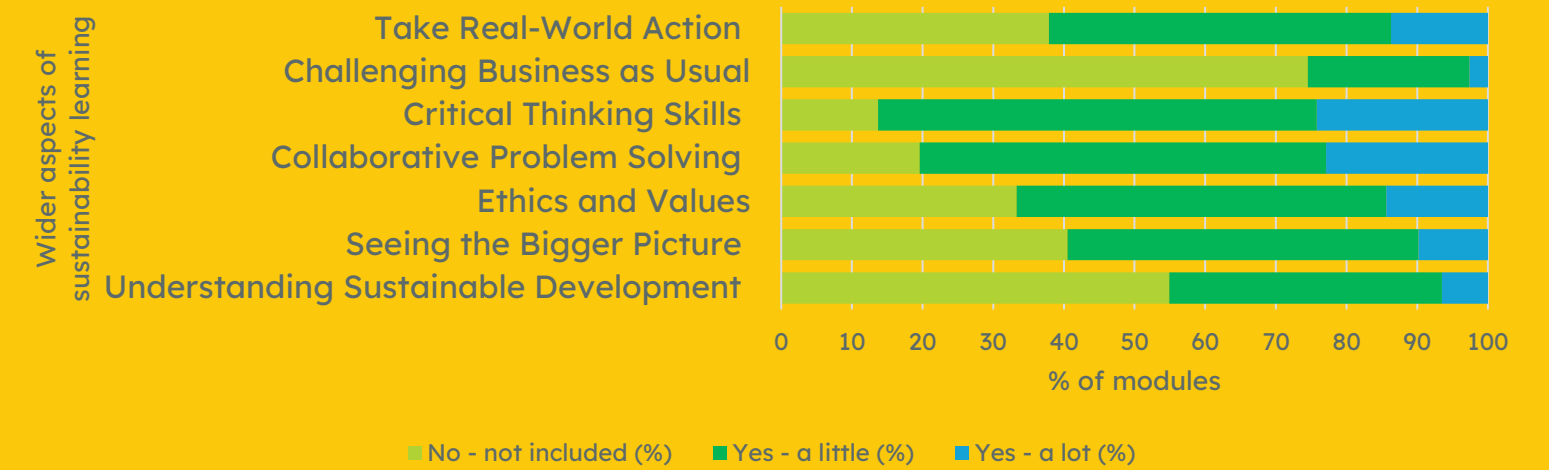
How it works

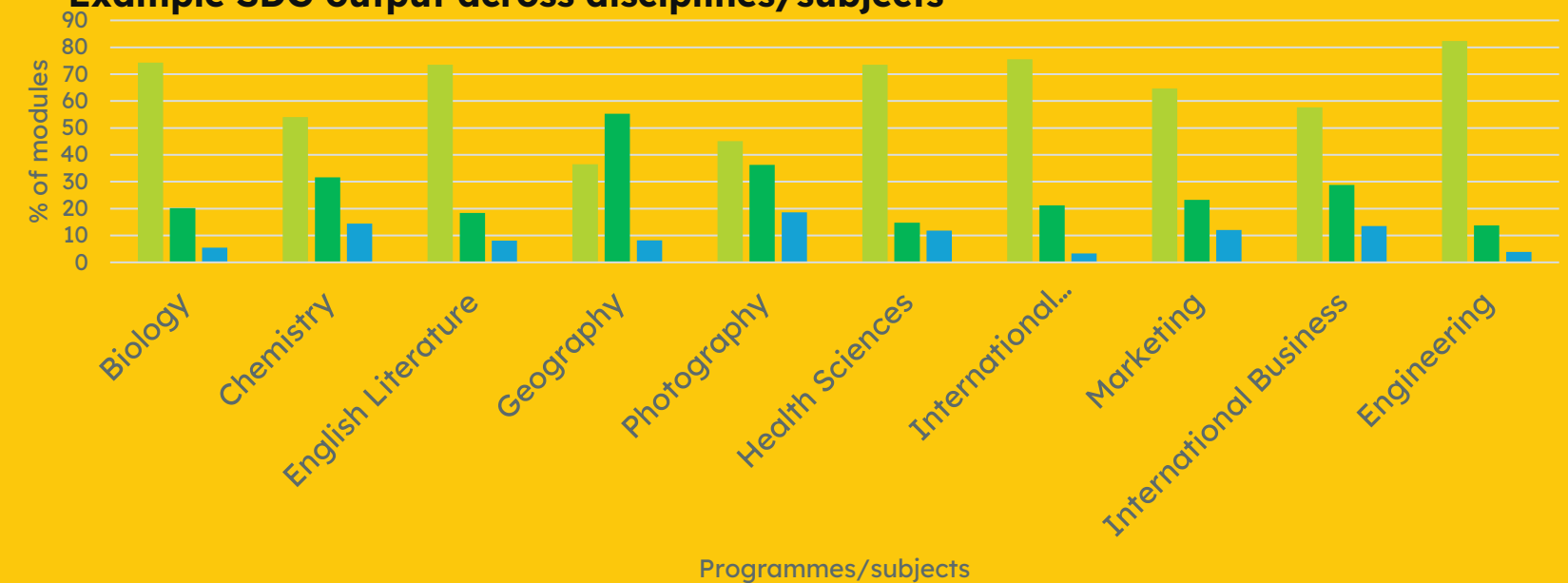
Example SDG output
